

Kirchberg-Kitzbuhel Austria Trip 1/26/24 to 2/3/24 42 Spaces Available

Bus from NHSC Club to JFK, depart approximately noon on Saturday 1/26 for group international check in at JFK. New EU requirement for a Visa which is a 5 minute on-line form and \$8 fee that each person needs to execute prior to going on the trip.

Flight Schedule is: 1/26/24 depart JFK on LH 411 at 5:30 PM to Munich (MUC) on Lufthansa arriving at 7:20 AM. Return on 2/3/2024 on LH 410 at 12:20 from MUC and arrive at JFK at 3:40 PM and then bus back to NHSC Club.

Hotel Zentral Kirchberg is where we will stay (<http://www.hotel-zentral.at/en/hotel-kirchberg>). Double occupancy. Non Ikon pass holders will need to purchase 5 day lift ticket when we get to Kirchberg. Current rates posted are 318 Euro (\$285) for 5 day or 6 day pass at 368 Euro (\$329) based on current exchange rates. Breakfast and dinner are included at the hotel. Walk to bus about 150 yards from front door. We will have a formal group dinner during the stay usually on Thursday.

Total cost with 5 day lifts **\$3,202**, but pay NHSC **\$2,917**. Ikon cost is **\$2,917**. We need attendees to make initial deposit of \$750 funds and additional funds by September 1st, Oct. 17th and final payment by Nov. 14th meeting dates. Single small room is **\$3,117** and we have 2 of them. You can pay in check or Venmo on-line payment.

A valid Passport is required that has more than 6 months prior to expiring. Passport renewals are taking 10 weeks for the State Department to process them.
